Gift of Membership and Friend Campaigns

As announced at our recent Annual Meeting, both the Gift of Membership and Friends programs are continuing. The campaigns have been very successful to date. As of the beginning of June, there were 132 full time members and 41 friends in our congregation.

The Gift of Membership Campaign was launched in late 2014 and invites prospective congregants to become TBY members for twelve months with no dues. It provides a "test drive" period to get to know a new community prior to making a commitment. We encourage joining the Sisterhood and Sidney Eagle Memorial Men's Club, participating in one or more committees, and joining in activities helping our greater community. New members joining as part of the Campaign are also eligible to join our religious school program and enroll their children for a modest fee.

The Friends membership program was adopted by the TBY Board in May 2015 and is open to those whose primary residence, as determined by the IRS, is located outside of the Delmarva Peninsula and who visit seasonally or on weekends. The annual \$250 fee, whether family or single, allows our Friends to avail themselves of multiple offerings, including honoring Yahrzeits, attending High Holiday services at no cost, and meeting our local community congregants whether at Shabbat Services or in social settings. Unlike our full-time members, however, persons in the Friends program are not eligible to vote

Our current Membership Committee, chaired by Immediate Past President Paul Schwab, consists of Steve Cohen (Ocean Pines, MD), Harlan Eagle (Salisbury, MD), David Fox (Arnold and Annapolis Area, MD), Barbara Garber (Millsboro Area, DE), Bob Kaplan (Fenwick and Selbyville, DE), and Jane Lafferman (Ocean View and Bethany Area, DE). An

opportunity is available for other congregant volunteers to join this group. At this time, we are particularly interested in adding an additional member who resides in Ocean Pines and one who in resides in Ocean City.

As noted in earlier newsletter announcements, all existing TBY members serve as extensions of our Membership Committee and would be very helpful in bringing our Campaigns, the robustness of our Temple life, and the exciting beginning of Rabbi Mills' tenure to the attention of friends and colleagues who might be interested in becoming a TBY member. Consider bringing a guest to our Beach Service on August 3, Shabbat Dinners before Services, and the upcoming TBY High Holiday Services. Caring Committee End of the Year Report 2018

In January 2012 Rabbi Warshaw shared with us her vision of a support group within the temple to help members during times of illness and grieving. Our mission statement is Hineinu: "We are Here, Because We Care." We are a committee of people who see those around us in pain and reach out beyond ourselves to care. We also celebrate happy occasions such as the birth of children, grandchildren, and great grandchildren. Rabbi Warshaw has continued to provide throughout the last six years her wisdom, guidance and teaching in *bikur cholim* (visiting and caring for the sick), communication skills, suggestions for prayers, condolence meals, shiva service and conducting a Shabbat service for someone who is in the hospital or housebound.

At our meeting in April we looked back over the past six years and shared how we have grown as individuals and how we have bonded as committee members. We learned that we are caring people, not care takers. We learned when it's time to reach out with a helping hand and when to step back to let professionals and family members take a larger role. Many of us here today have given and received loving care to and from our temple family.

Being part of this committee has been transforming, and brought us together. Over the years we have had to say goodbye to some of our committee members who have relocated or moved on to other areas. Recently we welcomed four new people to our group.

Temple Bat Yam is a place where each of us can feel that sense of being connected. It doesn't matter whether we are "regulars" or newcomers. It's our little community of people who care for one another. All are welcomed, wanted and needed.

Here are some of the things that the Caring Committee does:

- Celebrate new life by having a tree planted in Israel.
- Lend a caring ear and a shoulder to lean on.
- Run errands.
- Drive people to and from medical appointments.
- Donate and deliver meals when needed.
- Visit the sick at home, hospital, and rehab centers
- Make phone calls and visits to shut-ins.
- Send get well, condolence and celebratory cards.
- Assist with condolence meals and shiva.
- Provide information and resources.

We will miss Rabbi Warshaw. We are looking forward to continuing our sacred work with Rabbi Mills.
